

Taipei Medical University Outstanding Teacher Award (OTA)

Indicators and Procedures

- Article 1 In order to process the **Outstanding Teacher Award (OTA)**, abiding by Articles 7 and Article 10 of the "Taipei Medical University Teachers and Researchers Awards Regulations," the University sets up "Taipei Medical University "Outstanding Teacher Award (OTA) Indicators and Procedures" (hereinafter referred to as the Procedures).
- Article 2 **Outstanding Teacher Award (OTA)** rewards five full-time teachers of the University (including those of the Affiliated Hospitals) working for five consecutive years in the job, with outstanding teaching, research and service performances (two winners for the University and one for each of the affiliated hospital; If necessary, there can be no candidate recommended.) Each recipient is awarded with NTD 125,000. The rewards for teachers belonging to the affiliated hospitals are paid by the hospitals.
- Article 3 **Outstanding Teacher Award (OTA)** application can be filed individually or based on recommendation of colleges, departments or the student union. **The Outstanding Teacher Award (OTA) Selection Panel** shall be of seven to nine members (at least one from each of the affiliated hospitals), and are appointed by the Principal. The panel convener is elected among the committee members, who are responsible for reviewing the following annual items and corresponding proportion: (1) teaching (25%): teaching effectiveness and teaching situation; (2) research (25%): research paper publication, project execution, patent, technology transfer, awards; (3) Service (25%): internal and external, clinical service deeds and performance; (4) Special Contributions (25%): Model behaviors and achievements of the teacher.
- Article 4 During the application period announced by the Human Resources Office, the application form shall be filled out, and sent to the Human Resources Office, with the relevant information, to start the application. **The Outstanding Teacher Award (OTA) Selection Panel** will review and organize the applications basing on standards

of Article 3. The school evaluation committee will review, and submit results to the Principal for approval.

Article 5 After being selected, winners of **The Outstanding Teacher Award (OTA)** cannot apply again within five years. The same winner can have **the Outstanding Teacher Award (OTA)** no more than two times.

Article 6 The Procedures shall be promulgated and implemented after the approvals of the School committees; the same shall apply to the amendments
