

# Regulations Governing the Appointment of Emeritus Professors of Taipei Medical University

## Article I (Purpose)

To appoint retired professors of Taipei Medical University (hereinafter referred to as "the University") who have made extraordinary contributions to teaching and academic research as Emeritus Professors, the "Regulations Governing the Appointment of Emeritus Professors of Taipei Medical University" (hereinafter referred to as "the Regulations") are hereby established.

## Article II (Qualifications)

An Emeritus Professor shall meet at least one of the following qualifications:

1. Having served as a full-time professor at the University for fifteen (15) years or more, with outstanding achievements in academic research or teaching, and having made major contributions to the enhancement of the University's reputation.
2. Having served as a full-time professor at the University for a minimum of five (5) years, with exceptional contributions to academic research, and enjoying an international reputation.
3. Having served as the President of the University, and having made major contributions to the planning, construction, and development of the University.

## Article III (Definitions)

The nomination and review procedures for Emeritus Professors are as follows:

1. For individuals who meet the qualifications specified in Subparagraphs 1 and 2 of the preceding Article, a recommendation shall be jointly signed by five (5) or more full-time professors of the University. Upon receiving

consent from the Dean of the respective College or the Director of the Center for General Education, the individual's affiliated unit shall submit the recommendation to the University-level Faculty Evaluation Committee for review. Upon approval, a request shall be submitted to the President for final approval and appointment.

2. For individuals who meet the qualifications specified in Subparagraph 3 of the preceding Article, a request shall be submitted by the affiliated unit to obtain consent from the Dean of the respective College or the Director of the Center for General Education, and the appointment shall be finalized upon approval of the President.

#### **Article IV (Nature of the Position)**

The title of Emeritus Professor is an honorary position and carries no teaching obligations. However, should a relevant department, graduate institute, or degree program wish to leverage the professor's academic expertise, they may invite them to teach. Compensation for such teaching shall be disbursed in accordance with the hourly fee standards applicable to adjunct professors.

#### **Article V (Revocation Procedures)**

If an Emeritus Professor acts in a manner that damages the reputation of the University and the evidence is clear and conclusive, the case shall be submitted to the University-level Faculty Evaluation Committee for review. The honorary title of Emeritus Professor shall be revoked upon approval of at least two-thirds (2/3) of the committee members present at the meeting.

#### **Article VI (Matters Not Stipulated)**

Matters not stipulated in the Regulations shall be handled in accordance with the relevant regulations of the University and applicable government laws and regulations.

#### **Article VII (Authority for Enactment and Amendment)**

The Regulations shall be passed by the University Assembly, approved by the Board of Trustees, and subsequently promulgated for implementation. The same procedure shall apply to any amendments thereto.
